PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Students are provided with the basic knowledge and skills necessary to successfully complete the cosmetology course. The Cosmetology program will provide enrolled students with the state prescribed curriculum to become licensed cosmetologists. Students must complete 1500 hours of instruction to be eligible to take the licensing examination.

Program instruction includes sanitation/patron protection, facials, scalp and hair treatment, hair coloring, chemical hair restructuring, applied chemistry, anatomy, histology, physiology, manicuring/pedicuring and artificial nails.

Program delivery is contracted with Booker Institute of Cosmetology. Successful completion of pre-state practical and written examinations, plus the completion of all other course assignments precede the State of Michigan examination for licensure.
